

Free School Meal Entitlement

Don't miss out! Are you entitled to free school meals?

Could you be saving over £450 per child per year through claiming free school meals?

The high cost of raising a young family means that everyone could do with some help. If you are on benefits or unemployed you may be able to claim free school meals for your child.

Free school meals save you time and money and provide reassurance that your children are eating a healthy, balanced lunch every day.

Children whose parents receive the following support payments are eligible to receive free school meals:

- UNIVERSAL CREDIT (if earned income is included in the assessment of Universal Credit it must be less than £616.66 net per month).
- INCOME SUPPORT
- INCOME BASED JOBSEEKER'S ALLOWANCE
- INCOME RELATED EMPLOYMENT AND SUPPORT ALLOWANCE
- GUARANTEE PENSION CREDIT
- CHILD TAX CREDIT (without Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of £16,190 or less.

At Hawarden High School we also provide extra help with equipment, and look out to support in any way we can with families who are entitled to free school meals. This might be in the way of school trips or other extracurricular activities.

Parents living in Wales do not have to pay for their children's school lunches if they receive any of the support payments listed above. We are aware that some children who attend Hawarden High School are eligible for free school meals but don't know it.

If you think your family could qualify, please complete the form here or pick up a copy from the school office.

All students use the same anonymous 'fingerprint' system when paying for their school meal and therefore there is no difference if a child is on free school meals to a child who pays for their meals. The current allowance is £2.40 per child per day and can be used to purchase anything from snacks to drinks. Remember even if your child does not wish to have school lunches everyday they can use this money for drinks or at break time so it is worth claiming even if they have dinner in the evening.
