Dear Parent/Carer

As you will be aware Hawarden High School was designated a Childcare Resilience Hub at the onset of the lock-down and has provided continued daily child care facilities for children of key workers for whom there was no alternative provision. This provision is to continue even after the start of the reopening of schools to the wider school population from 29th June.

We understand that as schools and the rest of society begins the journey back to 'normality' increasing numbers of key workers will be returning to their roles and may well require child care facilities for their children where there is no alternative as both parents are working same shifts or single parent family.

Childcare continues to be only available at Hawarden High school for;

- Identified key workers where there is no provision for childcare from another responsible person living within the family home.
- Children deemed to be particularly vulnerable by the local authority.

However, parents must be clear that under the Welsh Governments directive, children cannot access child care support AND attend the school with the rest of their cohort as and when the school is reopening and this applies to the remainder of the school term.

Childcare provision will be available from 8.00 am to 5.30 pm each school day and children attending will receive a free packed lunch whilst present.

Parents who feel they are eligible to request childcare provision through the schools resilience hub setting should use the request form found on the school website and forwarded to hhfriends@hawardenhigh.flintshire.sch.uk giving at least one weeks' notice.
