

Introduction

The specification for English Literature in a “normal” year comprises of 2 units which together count towards the overall award of the English Literature AS.

Unit 1 Prose and Drama – this a written examination of 2 hours

Unit 2 Poetry Post-1900 - this is a written examination of 2 hours

In June 2020 WJEC announced amendments to the course due to the Covid-19 pandemic. However, no amendments were made to the AS Literature course.

Sources of evidence for Centre Determined Grades in AS English Literature

Assessment point 1 = WJEC ‘Jane Eyre’ past paper extract question completed at home under **low control** during first half term.

Assessment point 2 = A WJEC past paper exam question on ‘A Streetcar Named Desire’ completed at home under **low control**, week beginning 2nd November.

Assessment point 3 = A past Unit 2 single poem question from a WJEC paper, completed at home under **low control**, in the week beginning 8th February.

Assessment point 4 = N/A

Assessment point 5 = WJEC past **Unit 2 (poetry)** paper. Students to complete in class over three lessons, timed and monitored by teachers under **high control**. W.b. 10th May (provisional)

Assessment point 6 = WJEC past **Unit 1 (Jane Eyre and Streetcar)** paper. Students to complete in class over three lessons, timed and monitored by teachers under **high control**. W.b. 17th May (provisional)

Class work = A range of knowledge and skills is demonstrated by students in English lessons through their performance in low stakes summative assessment which includes verbal answers to questions and practice essays.

Non-Examined Assessment = Not applicable at AS Level.
